

Largest Kite Contest

The largest kite contest: Any Washington County School wishing to participate needs to have their kite and flying team assembled. Any kite that is entered in the competition must be at least 4 feet by 6 feet or larger. The winning kite will have the largest kite area, fly for 60 seconds or longer, be assisted by any number of students from the sponsoring school, and have no more than one adult per three students helping. First, Second and Third place winners will receive rewards for their respective schools. The First Place winner will earn \$1,000 for their school, the Second Place winner will earn \$750 for their school and the Third Place winner will earn \$500 for their school. In the instance, First, Second, or Third Place spots do not have a qualified kite that meets the above criteria, the decision of placement will be left to the judges. If the judges cannot make a unanimous decision, the head judge will have the final word.
